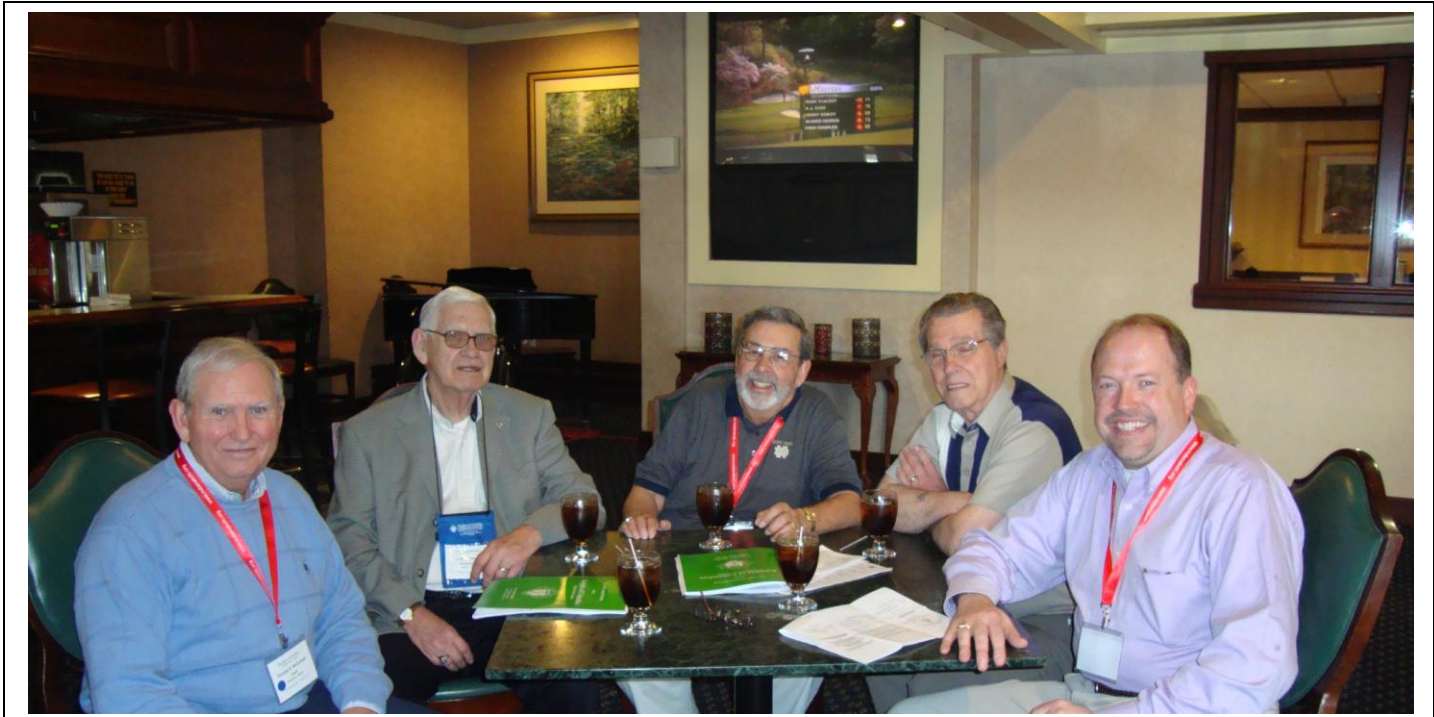


## Knights of Columbus Annual State Convention
