Currently the Fourth Degree is associated with "The Veterans Affairs Voluntary Service" whereby the Knights are able to lend their concern to bring comfort and solidarity to those confined in VA hospitals.

It is also worthy of note to mention the local Fourth Degree Bishop William Arnold Assembly with its Muncie connection. The Arnold Family at one time resided on East Charles Street not far from St. Lawrence Church. Such was the scene for a part of young William Arnold's youth. In preparation for the priesthood he attended St. Joseph's College in Rensselaer.

Throughout these formative years, and during his early years of the priesthood, William had a special interest in the military. Eventually he had the opportunity to serve as a Chaplain in the military. During World War II, Fr. Chaplain Arnold reached the rank of Major General and was the Chief of Chaplains during that conflict.

After his military service, Fr. Arnold was chosen to be Auxiliary Bishop to Cardinal Francis Spellman who at that time was in charge of our Catholic Military services persons. Bishop Arnold continued with his concern for our military until his retirement. Thus, our Bishop William Arnold Fourth Degree Assembly is fortunate to have this noted personage with a rich military background as its designated patriotic member.
