We Are An Easter People

We are an Easter People and 'Alleluia' is our song. This one word 'Alleluia' is a contraction of two words in English translated as 'I AM' taken from the Hebrew word 'Yehweh'.

In the Book of Exodus we read that God chose Moses to lead the Hebrews out of slavery in Egypt. When Moses wanted to know God's name to answer the people who would request who has designated him for this unusual role, God said 'I am' (Yehweh) is my name.

From that time forward only on very special sacred events would the high priest address the Most High with the title 'Yehweh'. On other occasions other titles – Adonai or Jehovah – were used. In New Testament testimony with Jesus in bitter confrontation with His enemies, Our Lord springs forth with the same identification: "before Abraham came to be, I AM." In so doing, Christ proclaims His divinity. This sealed His fate and charged with blasphemy.

The single name 'Yehweh' denotes prerogatives to the ultimate; namely, God is existence itself, total life and total being without without limitation. Such is the very nature of God as well as revealing Himself without the slightest possibility of error or deceit. For 'total' being leaves no place for any possible degree of 'not being'.

When we as Easter People in song and verse burst forth with 'Alleluia' to pass Jesus' test "not to be unbelieving but believe"; we are also on the privileged side of Our Risen Lord who said: "Blessed are those who have not seen and do believe."
