**The Year of Faith (Part II)**

Having looked at the 'when and why' of the Year of Faith (last month's newsletter), we should prepare how to live this special period as we strive to bear much fruit in achieving the two objects: 1) For all members of the Church to renew the basic teachings of our Faith 2) To promote a new evangelization of these sacred truths.

To seriously review the Catholic Deposit of Faith, every Catholic home should have a copy of the Catechism of the Catholic Church first published 20 years ago. If not this 700 page text, at least the condensed adult edition plus the special youth edition. These are both well indexed for quick and accurate answers.

Delve into the Bible to concentrate on a few selected texts especially in the Gospels as in John Chapter 8. These quotations are invaluable with the Divine Wisdom of Christ at his best: "I and the Way, the Truth, and the Life." "The Truth will make you free." "I am the light of the world." "He who follows Me will not be in the dark but will have the light of life." When Jesus boldly states "before Abraham came to be I AM," we are well armed with divine power to defend and live the objective principles of mortality.

To steady our resolve in the face of the present moral crises, a few excellent advocates can be suggested: Blessed Pope John Paul with 'The Gospel of Life,' Supreme Knight Carl Anderson with 'A Civilization of Love,' Archbishop Chaput with 'Render unto Caesar,' Cardinal Wuerl with 'Seek First the Kingdom.' Each selection calls for the faithful laity with a properly formed conscience to use opportunities in the public forum to make known the good news of the Gospel values.

Supporting means lending well approved church backing to intensify a more serious practice of our sacred liturgy centered in Mass and the Sacraments as well as diversified spiritual devotions. A wealth of Catholic literature deserves our interest in spiritual reading to admire the works and lives of the saints as well as other authentic guides for growth in holiness.

Finally, a few suggestions to help sustain a commitment to make the most of this Year of Faith. Have copies of the printed word as 'The Catholic Moment' at the diocesan level or 'The National Catholic Register' for broader perspective. Also, EWTN and Catholic Radio are good sources.

May these suggestions be of practical measure and helpful to position the Knights of Columbus in the front ranks and help them to bear much fruit for this year from October 2012 to November 2013.
